☞ World Environment Day-2022 ☞

On the occasion of “World Environment Day-2022” ENVIS-RP-NBRI organized a programme in collaboration with the Department of Botany, University of Lucknow and NASI-Lucknow-Chapter at University of Lucknow on the theme “**Only One Earth**” on 5th June 2022.

ENVIS-RP-NBRI has organized following online/offline competitions.

- 1) Online Quiz
- 2) Slogan writing (online/offline)
- 3) Opinion (online/offline) on the topic: Sustainability in Lifestyle for Environment
- 4) Drawing (online/offline) on the topic: Build Your Actions to Save the Environment
- 5) Debate (offline) on the topic: Circular Economy for a Sustainably Built Environment: “Go” or “No Go” for India.

Participants registered for events were of Undergraduate and Postgraduate levels along with Doctorate, and Post-doctorate fellows.

A total of **417 participants** were registered in which **336** entries were found eligible and **81** entries were ineligible (incomplete/double entries/not falling in the desired group). There were 201 participants registered for the online quiz, 61 for slogan writing, 85 for drawing competition, 44 for opinion writing and 26 for debate competition from different States of the country. In quiz, 25 Multiple Choice Questions (MCQs) were asked. The slogan writing was performed both in Hindi and English.

Prof. Pramod Tandon (Former Vice-Chancellor, NEHU, Shillong and CEO Biotech Park, Lucknow) delivered a key note address on the topic “**Climate Change an Imminent Reality: Feeling the Heat**” on the occasion. He mentioned increase of greenhouse gases in the atmosphere, leading to make our planet Earth hotter and corresponding changes observed in precipitation and crop production. Additionally, he warned that this will severely affect the economy of developing nations like India if the current lifestyle and industrial activities will continue to perform. Prof. Tandon elaborated steps to protect Earth, sustainable lifestyle practices, green vehicles, adoption of 3R principle etc.

A panel of experts comprising of **Dr. Vivek Srivastava**, Senior Principal Scientist, **Dr. Richa Rai**, Senior Scientist and **Dr. Anju Patel**, Scientist of CSIR-NBRI judged the entries received in different competitions held during the event.

The programme was hosted by **Dr. Nalini Pandey**, Head of the Botany Department, University of Lucknow, **Dr. Pankaj Kumar Srivastava**, Principal Scientist & Coordinator ENVIS-RP-NBRI, **Dr. Anju Patel**, Scientist & Co-coordinator ENVIS-RP-NBRI.

At the end of the event, ENVIS-RP-NBRI team members, **Mr. Sunil Tripathi**, Senior Programme Officer, **Mr. Diwakar Saini**, Information Officer and **Ms. Kaneez Fatma**, IT Officer, ENVIS-RP-NBRI distributed the ENVIS-RP-NBRI brochures, and issues of newsletters related to different topics on Plant and Pollution.

Dr. Shalini Srivastava, Associate Professor, Department of Botany, Lucknow University talked about 17 sustainable development goals and an urgent need to implement action points w.r.t. clean and affordable energy, zero hunger, quality education and quality water for everyone. She added that sustainable goals will only be achieved by the collaboration of common people, industries and governmental agencies. **Prof. Gauri Saxena**, Professor, Department of Botany, Lucknow University proposed a vote of thanks on the occasion of world environment day. emphasized that the new generation should come forward to act at the individual level as well as there should be strict policy norms regarding the conservation of water and soil. A vote of thanks was extended to the Vice-chancellor of Lucknow, President NASI and the entire team of ENVIS-RP-NBRI Lucknow. She extended thanks to all participants both offline and online for their participation in making this event successful.

To commemorate, World Environment Day, ENVIS-RP-NBRI planted 50 tree saplings including Ashoka (*Saraca asoca*), Peepal (*Ficus religiosa*), Sagwan (*Tectona grandis*), Kadamb (*Neolamarckia cadamba*), Palas (*Butea monosperma*) etc. in botanical garden of University of Lucknow with the support of Avadh Forest Division, Govt. of Uttar Pradesh.

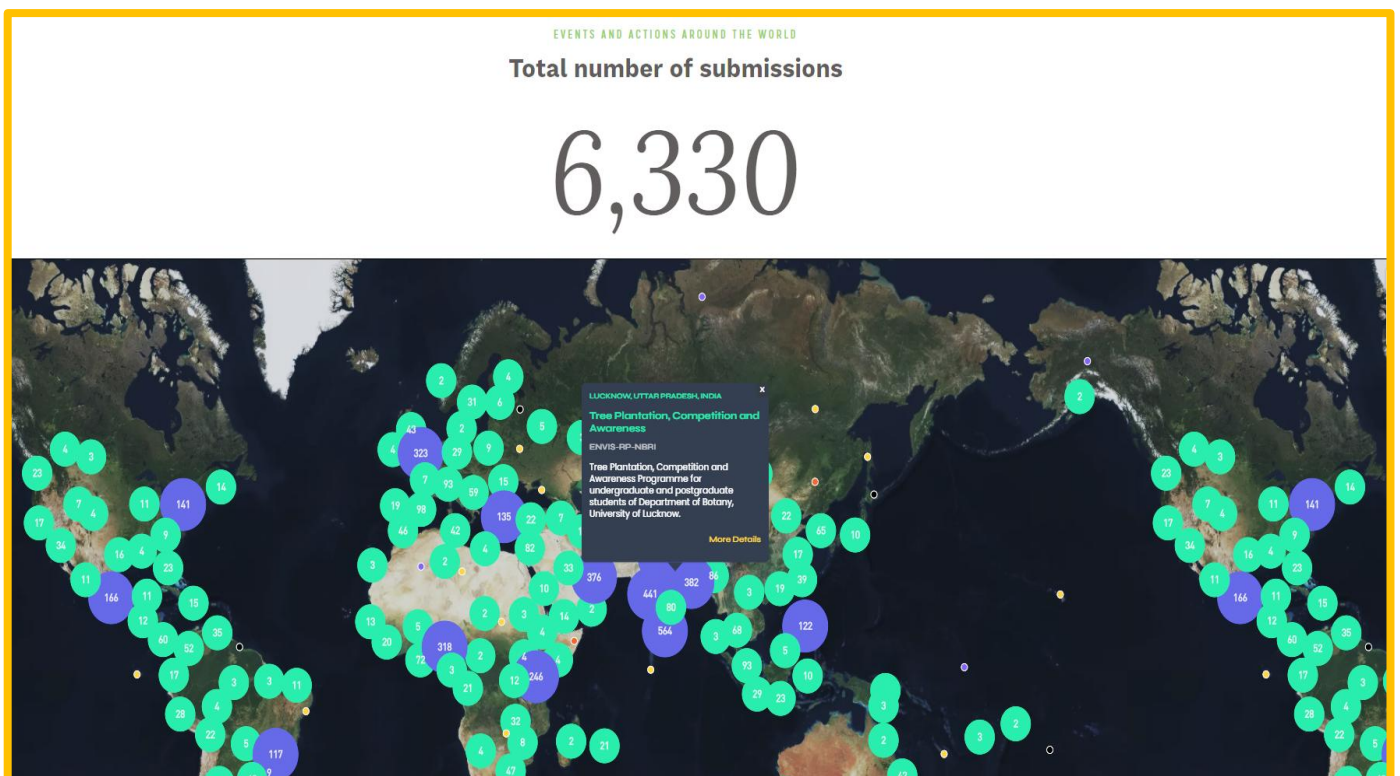

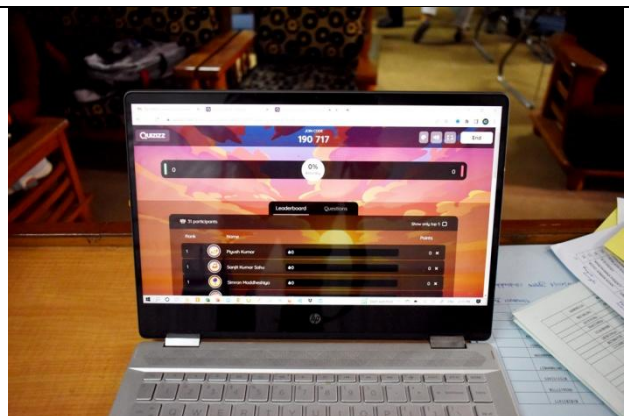

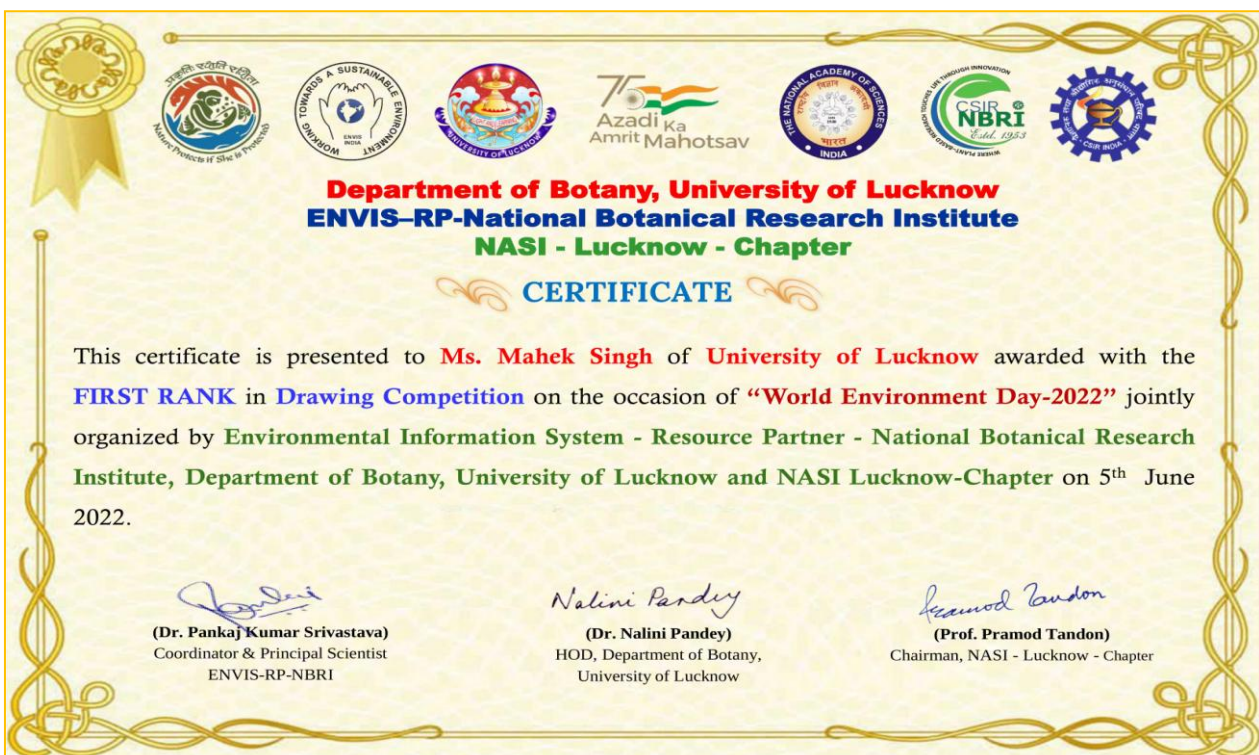
