On the occasion of **"World Environment Day-2021"** ENVIS-RP-NBRI has organised Online Competitions on the topic **"Actions, Choices & Voices for initiating join#GenerationRestoration"** under three categories **Poster, Cartoon and Short Essay** for School/ College/ University/ Institute students and general public.

Participants belong to **class V-VIII (Category-A), class IX-XII (Category-B), Undergraduates (Category-C) and Postgraduates (Category-D)** have taken part in the event. Deadline for submission of entries was **June 3rd, 2021 (Thursday) by 1800 hrs.**

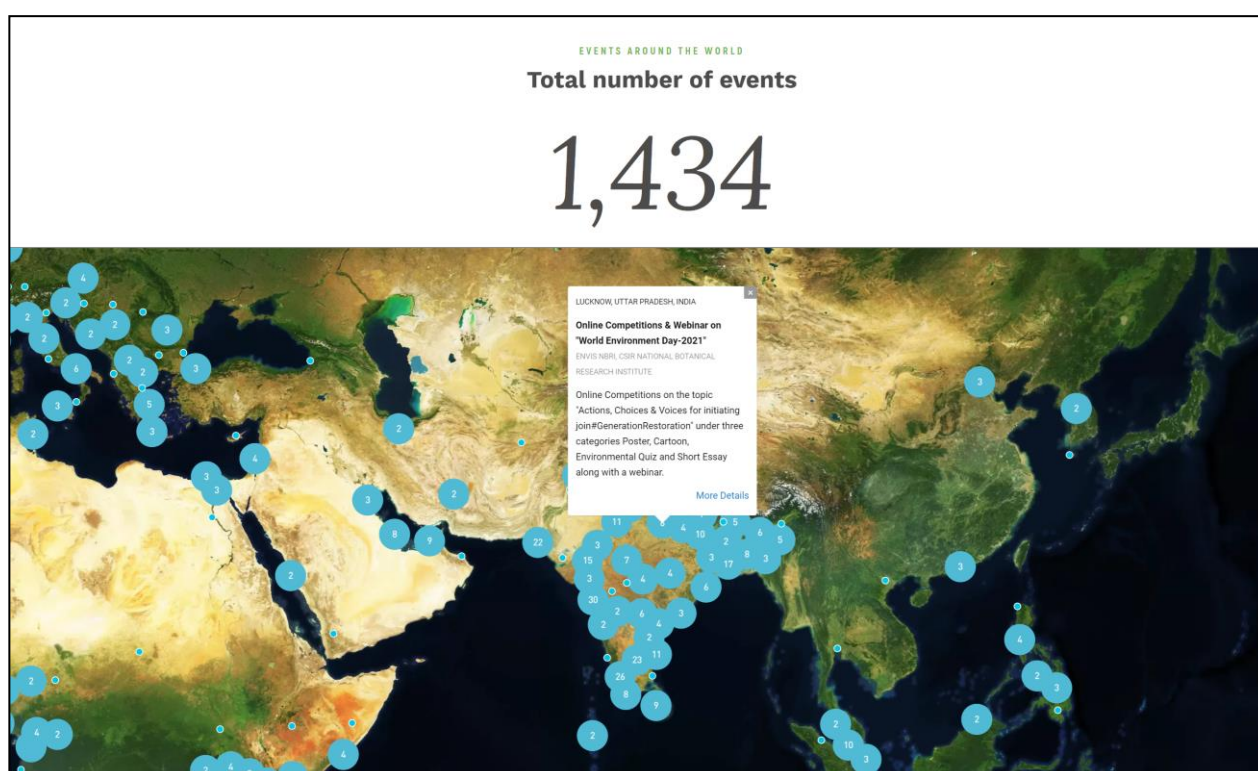

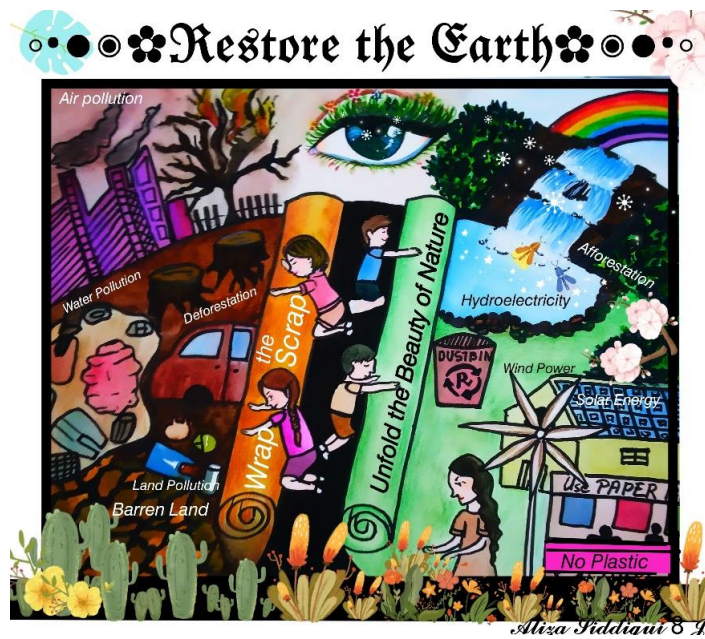

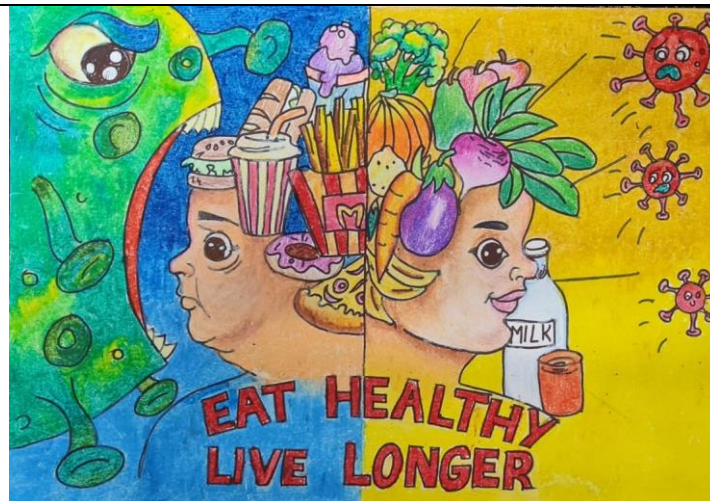

Meeting of the Expert Panel judging entries of Online Competitions (Poster, Cartoon and Short Essay) at CSIR-NBRI, Lucknow



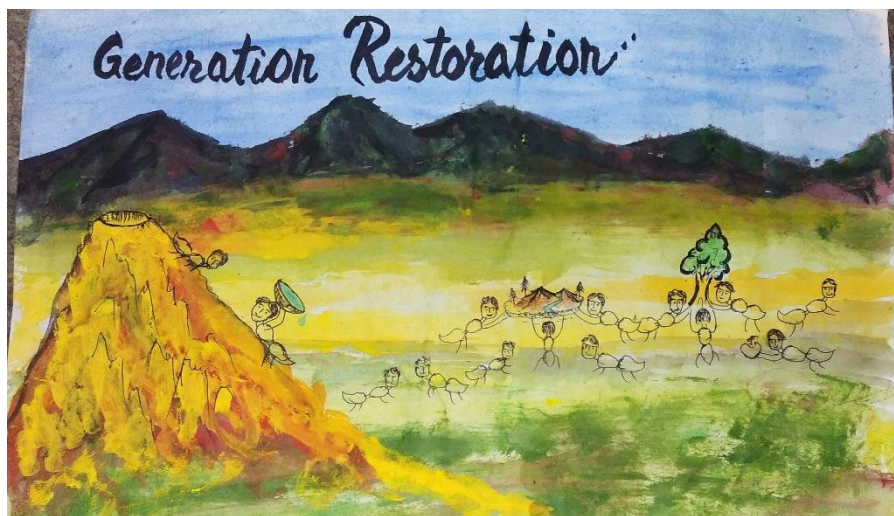
Best three posters in Category – A



Best three cartoons in Category – A

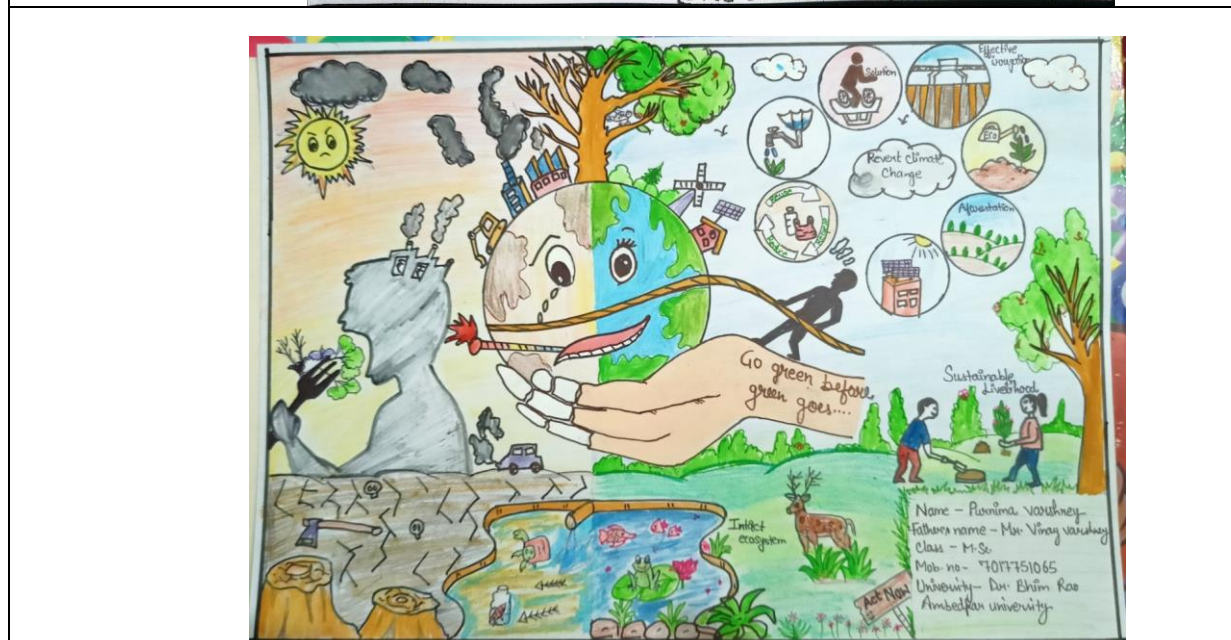
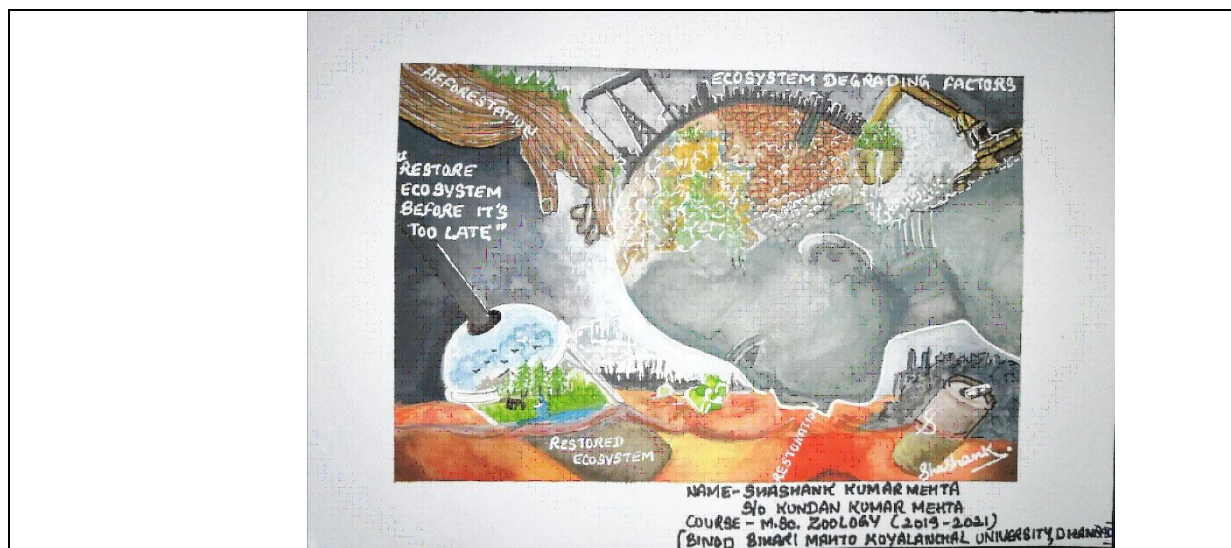

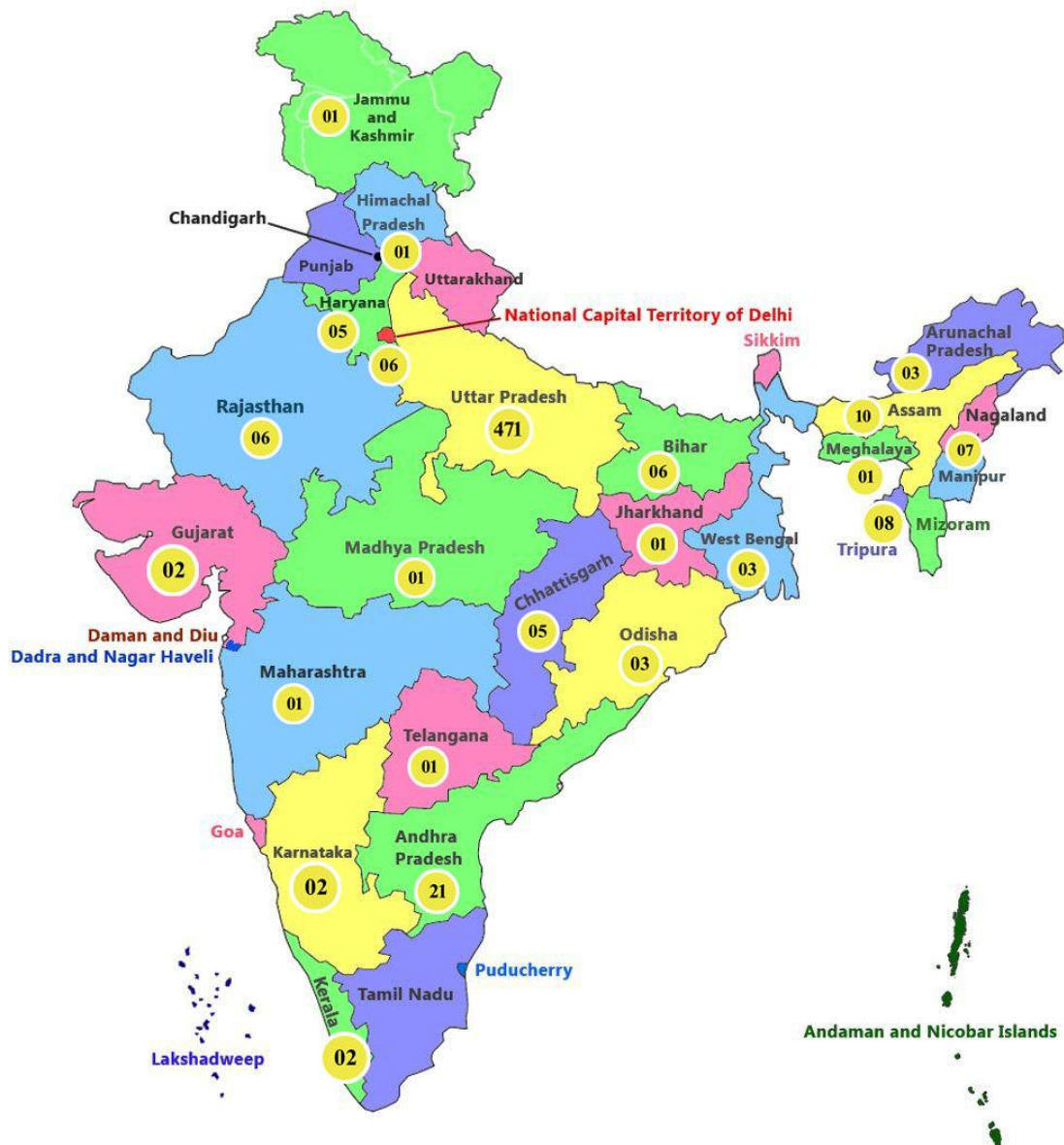

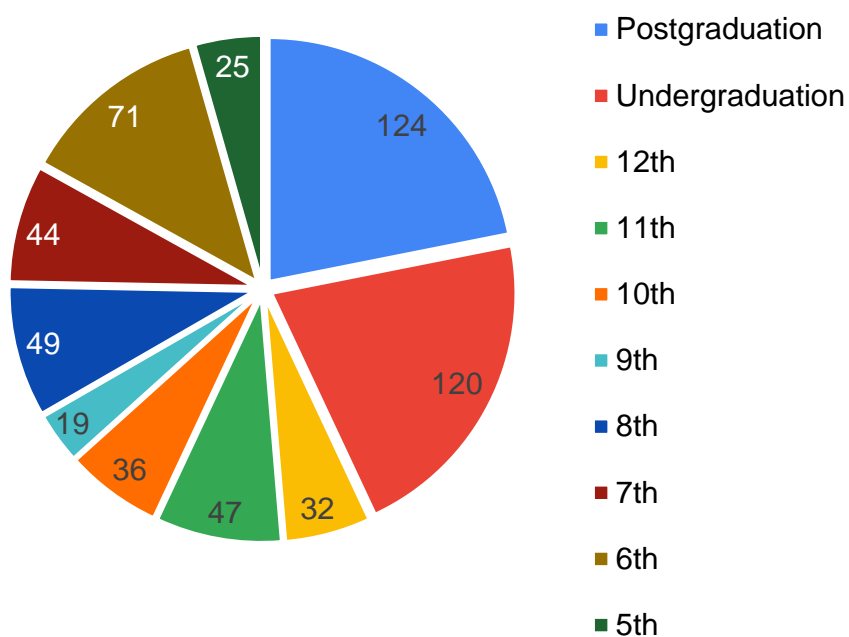
Results of different online competitions (Poster, Cartoon, Short Essay and Quiz) are mentioned above.

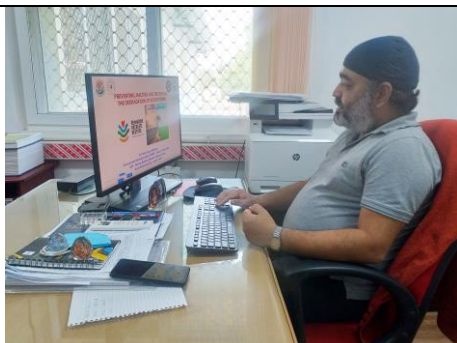


For webinars conducted on June 5th, 2021, total 567 participants ranging from postgraduates (124) upto class 5th (25) have registered themselves.

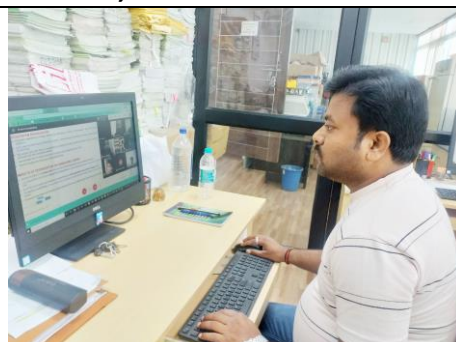
Webinars: Total 567 Participants belong to Different Classess



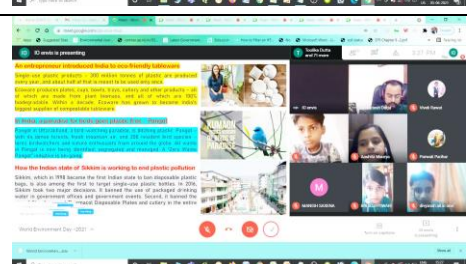
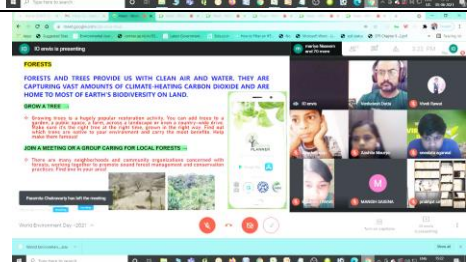
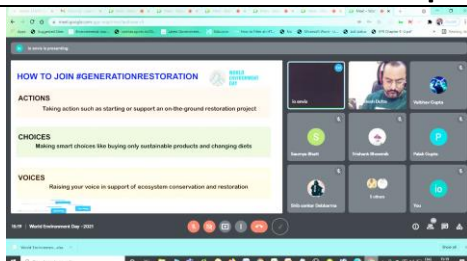

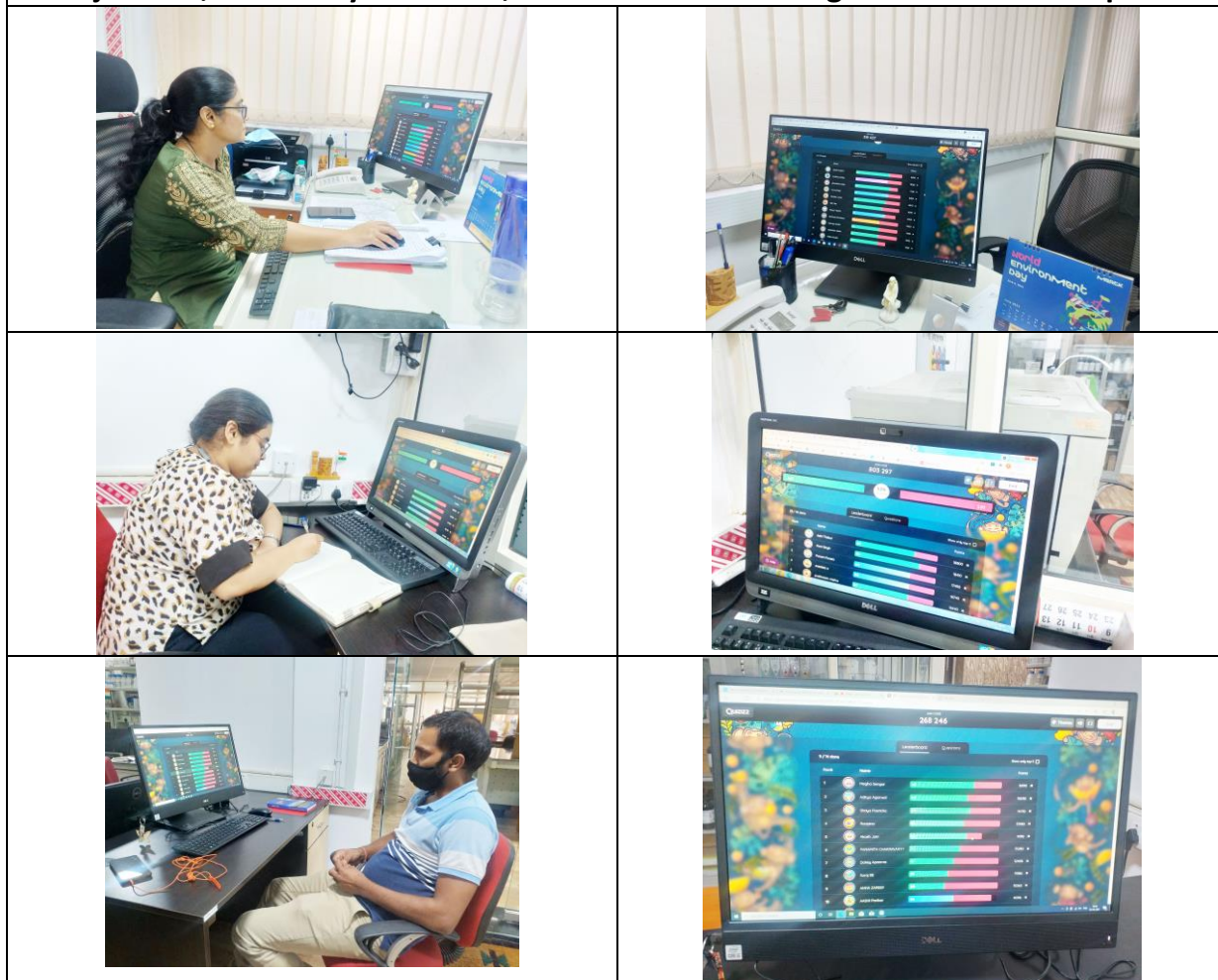
World Environment Day 2021 by ENVIS-RP-NBRI
