














Mission LiFE (Lifestyle for Environment) is an initiative launched by the **Hon'ble Prime Minister of India Shri Narendra Modi** at the UN Climate Change Conference (UNFCCC COP26) in 2021, to bring individual behaviors to the forefront of the global climate action narrative and with the aim of promoting sustainable living and protecting the environment. The mission focuses on various aspects of sustainable living, including the conservation of water resources, reduction of plastic waste, promotion of clean energy, and protection of biodiversity.

NBRI-EIACP Lucknow in collaboration with IWSLU-EIACP conducted Youth Parliament- Stage 1 (Uttar Pradesh) on May 17, 2023 at CSIR-NBRI Lucknow. The topic of the debate competition was "Individual behavior & habits have an impact on environment and climate change" and around 91 students from different schools, colleges, and universities belonging to 22 districts of Uttar Pradesh, participated in the event which was conducted in both online/offline (hybrid) mode.

Youth Parliament Stage I started with a *welcome address* by **Prof. Amita Kanaujia** (**Coordinator IWS-LU- EIACP and Professor University of Lucknow**) followed by the sensitization of Mission LiFE and EIACP centre activities by **Dr. Pankaj Kumar Srivastava** (**Coordinator NBRI-EIACP**, **Senior Principal Scientist**, **CSIR-NBRI**). Dr. Srivastava inspired students to change their behaviour by becoming followers of 'Lifestyle for Environment'.

Dr Ajeet Kumar Shasany Director, CSIR-NBRI initiated the pledge 'Mission LiFE'- Life Style for **Environment** and all the participants also followed and took the pledge.

Thereafter motivational wordings given by **Director, Dr. Ajit Kumar Shashny** "We must conserve our natural resources for our future generations. These types of events should encourage young minds to develop sustainable approaches in their life". He emphasized that India's traditional lifestyle naturally coexists with the environment, and changes adopted at the individual and societal levels are important to mitigate climate change.





In trail to the knowledge-gaining process, **Dr. Pramod Tandon, the Chief Guest of the event** sensitized the students with his reviews on sustainable development by the adoption of a sustainable lifestyle in our daily activities with a positive impact on the environment, which will not only help our environment to recover but will also help in avoiding any negative outcomes in future.





After creating awareness and sensitizing students about the impact on the environment and climate change the event started with a debate competition on the topic "Individual behavior & habits have an impact on the environment and climate change".

Students started sharing their views both online and offline on the topic. All the students were evaluated based on the content of debate, the way of presentation and the message conveyed to the audience. A total of **91** participants attended the Debate competition and **45** were present offline in the auditorium of CSIR-NBRI and 46 participants attended online. Participants belong to **20** different districts of Uttar Pradesh.
