


WORLD ENVIRONMENT DAY - 2023

#BEAT PLASTIC POLLUTION

Environmental Information, Awareness, Capacity Building and Livelihood Program Center (EIACP) at National Botanical Research Institute celebrated "World Environment Day" on 5th June 2023 in collaboration with Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose Government Girls Degree College and was hosted at the auditorium of NSCB.



34 theme-based Environment Information, Awareness, Capacity Building and Livelihood Programme Centers (EIACP) of the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, Government of India are working on different themes of environment and forest sectors. One such centres is at National Botanical Research Institute, Lucknow, on the theme of 'Plants and Pollution'.





The theme of World Environment Day 2023 was "#Beat Plastic Pollution".





The programme was started with a welcome address by Prof. Rashmi Bishnoi, Principal (Incharge) of Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose Government Girls Degree College. Dr. Pankaj Kumar Srivastava, Coordinator of NBRI EIACP Programme Centre and Senior Principal Scientist, CSIR NBRI Lucknow oriented students about Mission LiFE and activities of NBRI-EIACP Programme Centre.





Dr. Anju Patel, Co-coordinator of the EIACP Programme Centre and Scientist, CSIR NBRI Lucknow enlightened students about the theme of Environment Day 2023 and also highlighted the history of World Environment Day as well as emphasised ways to reduce plastic use and adapt alternatives of single-use plastics.

The Chief Guest of the programme was "Prof. Dhruv Sen Singh" Professor in Geology and Director at the Institute of Hydrocarbon Energy and Geo-resources, University of Lucknow, who enlightened the students about real facts about climate change and human-induced climate change.

Climate change is a natural process and has been witnessed over the geological scale. However, anthropogenic activities have enhanced a load of various pollutants like plastic into the environment. He motivated the students to take individual steps to reduce plastic pollution and think before buying plastics.







Total **65** participants attended the event and 24, 17 and 44 participated in the *Slogan*, *Drawing* and *Quiz* competition.


